Position Summary:

This position requires the candidate to work as one member of a three-person crew on either a paper coating or paper slitting machine.

Paper Coater Operator:

This position performs various duties to assist the Lead Operator in the set-up and operation of a coating machine including: set-up and operation of the unwind station; participating in changeovers; participating in set-ups and operations for product coating trials; and other similar duties necessary to produce a variety of thermal imaging products using water based coatings within established quality and quantity standards.

Paper Slitter Operator:

This position performs various duties to assist the Lead Operator in the set-up and operation of a paper slitting machine including: setting up paper slitter; labeling, marking, wrapping, and packaging finished cuts as per specifications; relocating incoming and outgoing rolls to and from the slitter; and other similar duties necessary to produce finished thermal paper rolls.
